







Beijing Great Wheel Location

The Beijing Great Wheel is one of China's most prestigious government supported tourism projects, comprising a giant observation wheel with supporting commercial facilities to be built in Beijing's Chaoyang Park (CYP). CYP is a popular spot for locals and sport enthusiasts and has over 20 amusement rides. It is also the location of the Olympic Volleyball Stadium.

Accessibility

-  Subway: Nearest Station: Tuan Jie Hu, Subway Line No. 10
-  Taxi: Accessible to each gate at CYP
-  Car: There is a 200-Lot Car park onsite
-  Bus: Route numbers servicing East Gate: 952, 988, 99, 740, 840, 628, 976, 973, 852, 111 (A total of 37 buses service CYP)
Site Address: Chao Yang Park No. 3 East Gate



Chaoyang Park is located to the northeast of the city centre and is on the East Forth Ring Road. This is the main route from the city to the airport. The park has a total area of 320 hectares and is approximately 2.8 kilometers long, 1.5 kilometers wide.
